Hannon House Program Detail Form

How Do I Get In?

Complete an application and then an interview will be set up with you so we will need a way to contact you. Upon approval you will be given a bed date and a time to arrive.

What Do I Bring?

Basic clothing, approved medications, cell phone (if you have one), and toiletries. We provide toiletries if needed for the first month. There is NO storage available for your personal items such as furniture, collectibles, etc. Please rent a storage unit for these items. One vehicle per person only and with valid driver's license, auto insurance, and registration.

<u>Hannon's House Resident Requirements</u> (brief version)

- 1. \$450 per month (no deposit) fee due each month (assistance available).
- 2. This is a minimum 90 day treatment program then a continued stay review with your team will determine medically necessity then the Medicaid Medical Review Panel will review your case for further services on a month to month basis.
- 3. You will sign a Release of Information (ROI) so that information can be exchanged between Hannon's House/Instar Community Services and whoever is involved in your recovery program.
- 4. Management can search person and room if we feel there is reasonable suspicion that contraband is present. Refusal will result in being asked to leave the program.
- 5. Urinalysis will be required upon request and random. We use Millennium Health and your insurance can be billed. **PLEASE NOTE:** A decision can be made at any time for you to leave the home for substance use at any time.
- **6.** Guests are allowed on the premises upon prior approval by manager.
- 7. Pets or weapons of any kind are prohibited.
- 8. This is a Recovery House; you must check in with the house manager daily and discuss your recovery maintenance or as needed.
- 9. Alcohol, drugs, drug paraphernalia, illegal or stolen contraband will NOT be permitted on the premises.
- We are a 12-bed licensed residential recovery community where men living with a substance use disorder and/or mental health issues restore their lives in a therapeutic home environment. We have on site support 24 hours per day. Assistance with employment, drug and alcohol recovery, mental health care,
 - medical appts, laundry, cable, internet, meals and full shared kitchen.

 7 hours per week of life skills and treatment activities is required.
